Breakfast: HEIA Restaurant, Bd de Pérolles 80, 1700 Fribourg (next to Per21)



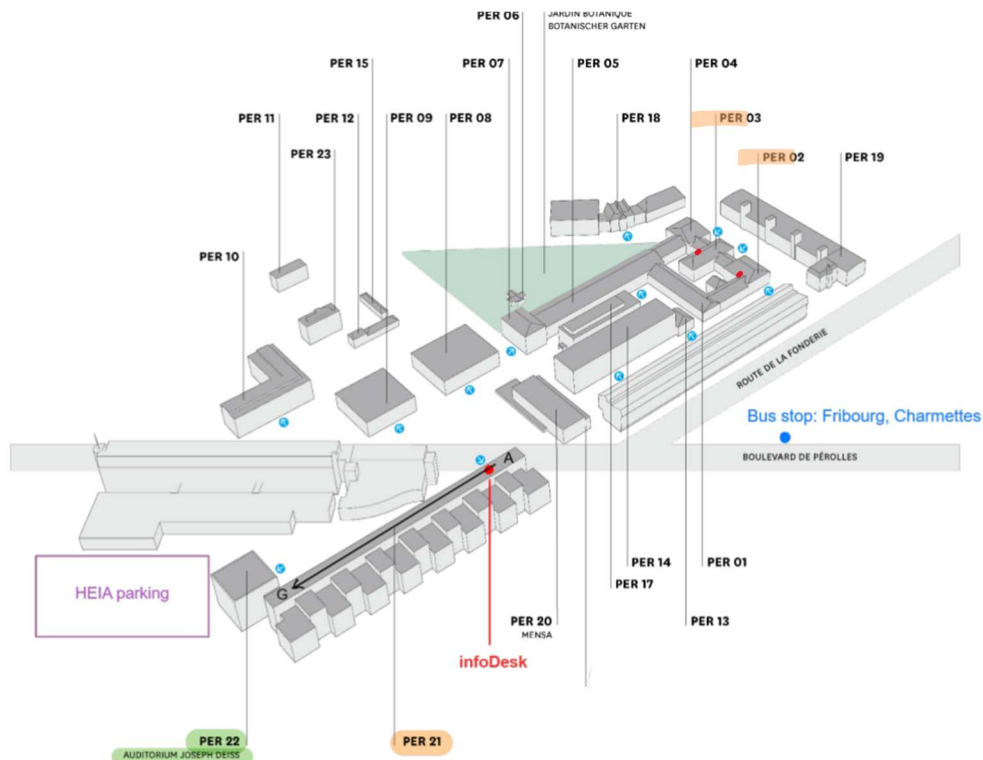
FriBOWling: Rue Saint-Pierre 6, 1700 Fribourg
