Swiss Medical Students Convention Fribourg 2025

The Convention on Longevity “*Push the Limits of Time: Lifespan Revolution*” begins on Friday, October 17, with **check-in opening at 19.00h at Centre Fries**. 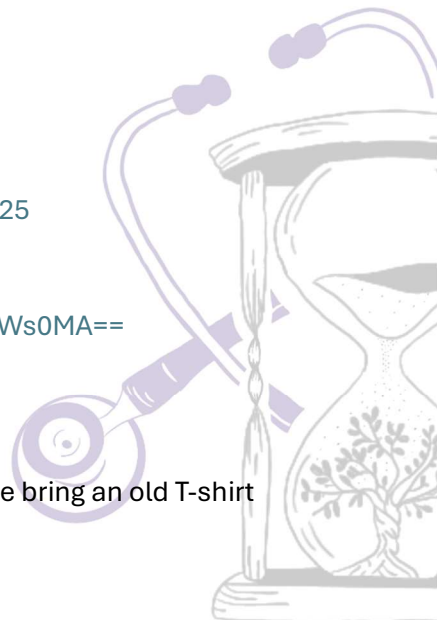

Centre Fries: Rue Guillaume Techtermann 8, 1700 Fribourg → closest bus stop is Fribourg, Fries 3 minutes from the train station.





Korso: Pérolles 15, 1700 Freiburg until 01.45h



Check-in and ceremony at pérolles 21, a building on the campus de pérolles → closest bus stop is Fribourg, Charmettes or Fribourg, Plateau-de-perolles 10min from the train station

Breakfast : HEIA Restaurant, Bd de Pérolles 80, 1700 Fribourg



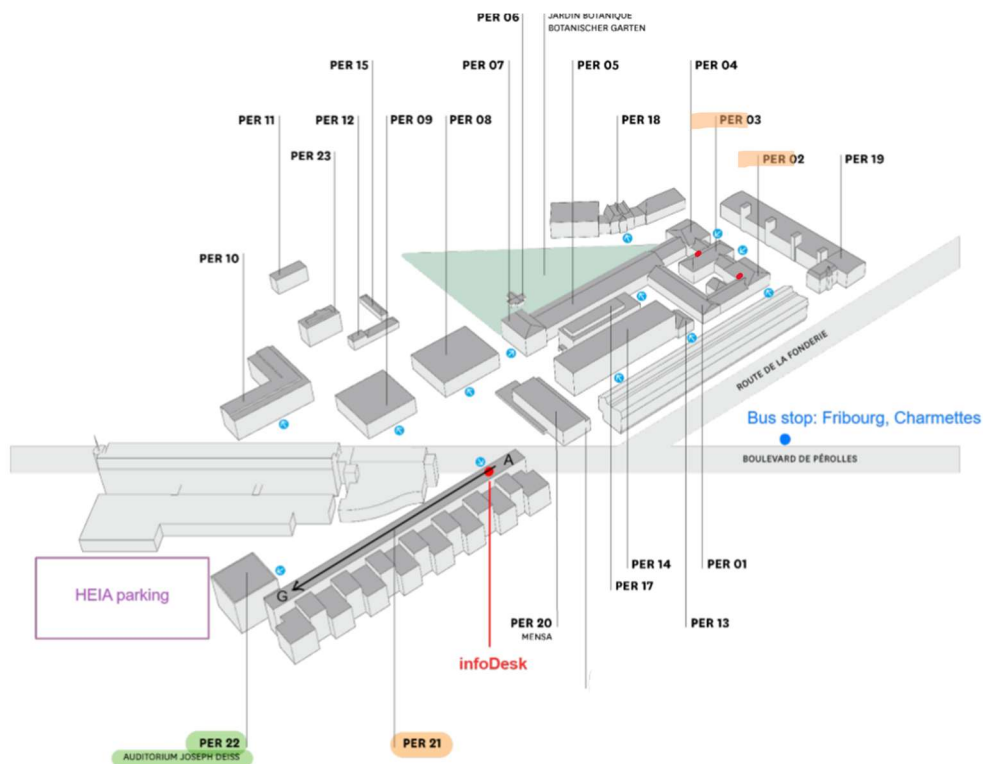
Fribowling: Rue Saint-Pierre 6, 1700 Fribourg
